Application Process for \$3000 Grants for Course Redesign

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OVERVIEW OF GRANTS

- Faculty may apply for \$3000 grants to redesign high-enrollment or high-demand courses.
 - Purpose: To expand upon the initial statewide course redesign initiative.
 - Proposals need approval of their campus provosts and chairs.
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PROCEDURE

- **Consult with your campus contact before developing a proposal to discuss:**
 - Applicable deadlines
 - Campus resources that will be available to support your course redesign.

TIMELINE FOR APPLICATION

- **Jan 15, 2013: Readiness Criteria report due**
 - **Final Project Plans**
 - March 15, 2013: Due to campus contact
 - (April 1, 2013: Campus forwards to UM System)
 - **April 30, 2013: Grant recipients announced**
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TIMELINE FOR REDESIGN TEAMS

- **Summer and/or Fall 2013: Team redesigns course**
- **Spring 2014: First offering of redesigned course**

Readiness Criteria

This step may be an optional step for your campus so ask your campus contact if the readiness criteria report is required.

REDESIGN PROCESS: SUMMER/FALL 2013


- **Courses are redesigned by campus teams.**
 - **The course redesign will be supported and managed by staff on the respective campus.**
 - **MLC Scholars will also be available for consultation.**
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INITIAL OFFERING: SPRING 2014

- **Typically a pilot implementation where some sections are traditional and some are redesigned.**
- **Your campus may permit beginning with a full implementation – check with campus contact for details.**



OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS

- Collect student outcome data and cost data to be submitted to a central coordinator.
 - Submit course materials for posting on the MissouriLearningCommons.org website for the use of others who are interested in redesigning their courses.
 - Present at a statewide course sharing workshop.
